Pizzano intercepted a forward pass on Wenonah's 40-yard line and Boote took it over from the 10-yard line after a 25-yard run around right end. Brodie failed to kick the extra point.

Brodie got loose and carried the ball to the one-yard line and Ness went through centre for the third touchdowr, and Brodie added the extra point by a drop kick. Schwartz blocked a punt on Farm School's 40-yard line and recovered the ball and carried it for five yards. On a trick play, Wallace skirted left end for the last score.
